...then Metro is for you.



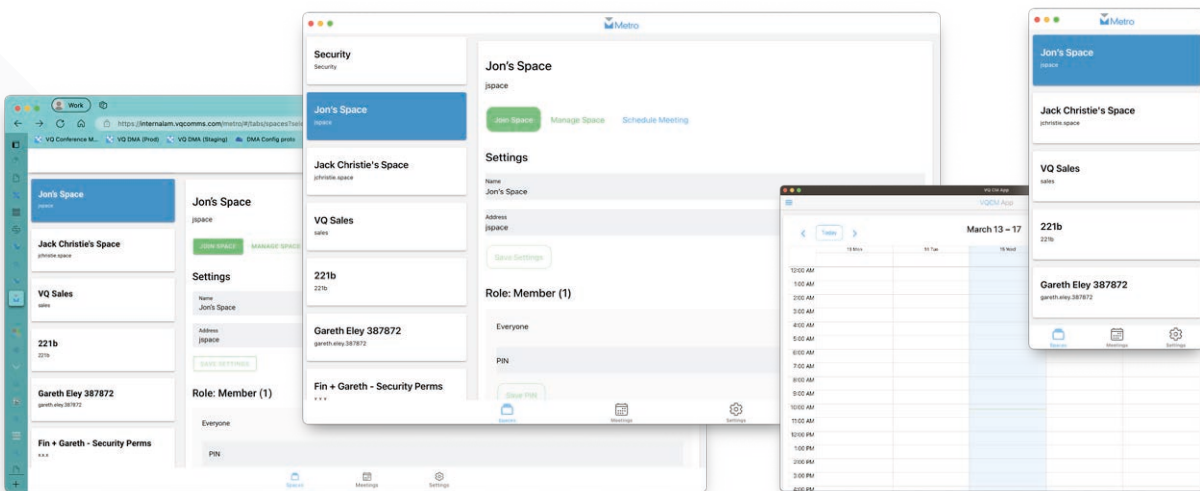

With Metro, we make life a little easier for everyone who needs to make calls.

New concepts such as "Service Calls" for Translation or Sign-language-interpreter build on this by enabling additional services that help the user have successful and productive calls.

And because Metro supports multiple languages, users don't always need to read the UI in English.

The 'low/no touch' nature of the Metro application enables its deployment quickly and seamlessly without additional infrastructure or often complex application 'packaging'.

#### Metro for Outlook Add-in

Integrate VQ Conference Manager with Outlook for Microsoft 365 using the Outlook Add-in.

#### Metro for Outlook Plug-in

For those using on-premise Exchange and needing rich call functionality.

#### Metro for Teams

Brings CMS capabilities to Teams users. From Teams, users are able to cross launch a call from Teams to CMS. No requirement to leave one call and then join another. Add Cisco levels of call predictability to your Microsoft Teams environment.
