Come and meet with us in our Meeting Rooms. They are not intended to be "broadcasts" where we speak and you listen. Nope. We want to be able to show you what we're doing (or think we're going to do), talk about the logic behind what's in the plan and roadmap but, most importantly, listen to you and your view of the functionality you need to enable you to deliver the services you need to deliver to your user base.

These meetings are being hosted by the product managers and engineers at VQ that design, build, test and support our products and define our roadmap.





VQ Meeting Rooms

Come and meet with us in our Meeting Rooms. We're running the following sessions.

Our meeting rooms have whiteboards and we expect these sessions to a mixture of demos, whiteboarding and interactive discussion (slideware lite). We're planning on them being 45 minutes long, but if you need more or less time we can plan what you need.

Roadmap	Walk thru and discussion on VQ product family roadmap and direction of travel.
Meeting Services	Call Builder, Focus and Compact views and refinements to Reactive Calls. Search is being refined. Blast Dial gets more refinements in 4.5. User interface evolution to the style used by DMA. Initial plans on multi-cluster support. What is the functionality you need to see in Meeting Services?
DMA	We'll be launching 4.4 at CLUS featuring File Server, CUCM importer and quality of life improvements.
TMS migration into DMA	Be taken thru the process and use the opportunity to meet the expert.
Microsoft 365 Connector and Hybrid Calendar	New coolness that will playbook install onto the 4.4 platform. Opens the door to external service meeting invites (Webex and Teams) appearing as OBTP green join buttons on your room systems. Demo gods permitting, we should also be able to show CVI working.
HA Overview	By CLUS, we'll have HA systems in beta. See it running and talk with Tim about the HA design, what it will and won't do. Discuss your requirements and suitability.
HA deployment	Talk with Tim about the detail of deploying HA in fine detail. Typically, this will have been done after having done a HA Overview session.
DMA MTR	DMA controlling RoomOS based devices in MTR mode. One of the key features of DMA is that it significantly reduces the pain of managing more than 1 MTR device; think of the gain when you have hundreds.
Metro (Outlook, Teams, Voice & Service Calls, iOS and Android)	Metro 1.1 has had a lot of love with bug fixes and polish. At CLUS, we'll be showing Metro working in Outlook and the latest Teams integration. And if the Gods are smiling, the Metro Voice concept, Native iOS and an Android flavor (NSA Approved)
Migrations (VQCM 3->4)	Planning an upgrade; come and talk it thru
Kibana and Analytics	Open session with Ethan, VQ's Kibana lead engineer. Everything you wanted to know but were too shy to ask.
